



FINDING TEMPORARY SUMMER WORK 5 TOP TIPS

START LOOKING NOW.

TAKE YOUR JOB SEARCH OUTSIDE.

REGISTER WITH A RECRUITMENT AGENCY.

Many local businesses rely on recruitment agencies to find skilled seasonal staff. If possible, register in advance and keep your consultant informed about your availability.



TAILOR YOUR CV FOR TEMP WORK.

When looking for temporary work, your CV should state your availability clearly. It should be primarily focused upon your relevant experience, transferable skills and positive attitude. If you are open to working in different sectors, i.e. hospitality and office based temp work, don't be afraid to make a few versions of your CV.

BE FLEXIBLE.

You probably have loads of things planned for summer already, but snapping up the best summer job opportunities may require you to be a bit flexible with your diary. Set aside time for job hunting, but also be open to last minute interviews and shift work.
