## BRG Moves Up The Charts

Berry Recruitment Group (BRG) has moved up nine places in the rankings for privately-owned businesses headquartered in Hertfordshire.

The St Albans-based company was placed at number 55 by Grant Thornton, the accountancy giant – up from 64 in 2015.

Rankings are based on turnover and BRG anticipates a figure well in excess of £60m for 2016.

The company has more than 30 branches across the country, including a rapidly expanding one in Hatfield, Herts. The family-business employs more than 200 staff and has recently expanded its operations in London.

Spencer Berry, Business Development Director of BRG, said: “Moving up nine places in the rankings for privately-owned businesses in Hertfordshire is something we’re very pleased about. Our Hatfield branch in the county is typical of our successes around the country – it has moved into bigger offices and employed more staff. The branch has a really experienced team and has recently taken on apprentices who we are training. Recruitment is a good indicator of the economy and we are seeing positive signs going forward.”
